Mastering shorthand when a mere boy, he went to work on the Cork Herald, and later on the Cork Examiner. Even then he took an active interest in Irish affairs. Longing for the freedom denied him at home and with heart bleeding for his suffering country, he came to America in 1887. Joining the staff of the Boston Globe, he was for some time private secretary to the Managing Editor. His first important newspaper work in America was in the gubernatorial campaigns of William E. Russell. Representing the Globe, he accompanied the youthful Governor in his three contests, and aroused his admiration by the thorough manner in which the work was done. He reported the celebrated Trefethen case in both trials, and the famous trial of the seaman, Bram. Gifted with a marvellous memory, he interviewed with remarkable accuracy, scores of prominent men, National and...
